1.	Introduction to the car – inside and out, backing, turns, observation and blind spots, stopping, railroad tracks, speed limits and drop-offs.	1.5
2.	Review 401 - getting on and off - changing lanes/passing - space cushion/bubble and observation	1.0
3.*	Review (turns etc. and 401) turnabouts, perpendicular and hill parking	1.0
4.*	gravel, secondary roads, highway (passing), parallel parking, roadside stop, vehicle stall, review	1.0
*lessons 3 & 4 may be combined into a 2-hour session		
5, 6	Introduction to driving in London Mid - term test	2.5 - 3
7, 8, 9	Downtown London Student will self-navigate to a spot in London (NOT White Oakes)	2.5 - 3
10, 11 **	Final Test – London – review city driving, turnabouts and parking. TWO STUDENTS IN THE CAR.	2.0hrs.per student if 2 2.5 hrs. if one student.

1. It is very important that the student drives with parent or any other driver (4 years minimum, at least a “G class”) frequently. Twelve hours of instruction time is not enough to turn a complete novice driver into a safe and competent driver! **Fifty hrs. documented to be handed in.**
2. At any stage, a student could be told that the next lesson will be delayed until he/she gets more practice time with parent etc. OR that maybe extra lesson(s) is (are) needed (\$50./hr.).
3. Student will not pass unless instructor is confident in student’s ability to drive alone.
